HAYCOCK TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE No. 9

NOTICE!

The Haycock Township Board of Supervisors will meet at the Haycock Fire House, Thursday, January 11, at 8 p. m. in special session and will consider the following ordinance for adoption.

ORDINANCE NO. 9

AN ORDINANCE REGULA-TING JUNK YARDS, RUB-BISH DISPOSAL DUMPS. LIQUID WASTE DISPOSAL DUMPS OR LACOONS, GAR-BAGE DISPOSAL DUMPS. PIGGERIES. AUTOMOBILE GRAVEYARDS, AND OTHER OFFENSIVE BUSINESSES AND PROVIDING PENAL-TIES. FOR THE PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY, WELFARE

SECTION I

It shall be unlawful for any person, co-partnership, or corporation to use or occupy any premises in the Township of Haycock as and for a junk yard, rubbish disposal dump, liquid waste disposal dump or lagoon, garbage disposal dump, piggery, automobile graveyard, or any other offensive business within the Township of Haycock, whereby any noxious or offensive odors putrid or polluted waters, or other discharge, smoke, refuse, rubbish, or filth of any nature whatever, is blown, carried, or discharged in any manner, onto the public roads, or upon the premises of other persons, co-partnershops or corporations. The use or occupation of any premises within Haycock Township in a manner so as to violate the provisions of this section is hereby declared to constitute a nuisance per se.

SECTION II

It shall be unlawful for any person, co-partnership or corporation to dispose, keep, place or store, or permit to be disposed, kept, placed or stored on any premises whatsoever, any rubbish, junk, garbage, ashes, liquid waste, manure, or refuse of any kind whatever within three hundred feet of the right-of-way of any public roads, or within one hundred feet of any creek or stream. The use or occupation of any premises within Haycock Township in a manner so as to violate the provisions of this section is nereby declared to constitute a nuisance

SECTION III

Any person, co-partnership or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon summary conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine not exceeding \$300.00 or in default thereof, be sentenced and committed to the county jail for a period not exceeding thirty days.

SECTION IV

The township may institute proceedings in equity for the purpose of enforcing the provisions of this ordinance.
